

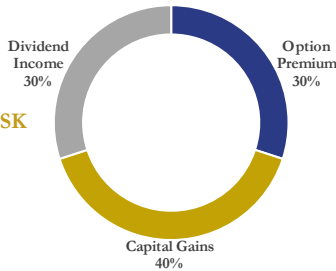

OUR METHOD

- Seek to provide above average equity **income** generated from dividend paying large cap value stocks and premium collected from writing covered calls.
- We believe writing covered calls on approximately half of each position could provide **reduced risk** to a portfolio by showing lower volatility over the long term.
- Leaving approximately half of each individual position uncovered can allow for **growth**.

Fund Objective: The fund seeks current income and realized gains from writing options with capital appreciation as a secondary objective.

- Dividend paying stocks which we believe are high quality.
- Call options sold on existing positions.
- Index put options purchased in extreme cases with the goal of protecting the principle of the fund.

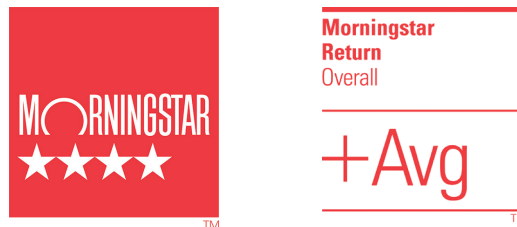

***Important Definitions:** Call Option: An agreement that gives an investor the right (but not the obligation) to buy a stock, bond, commodity or other instrument at a specified price within a specific time period. Call options involve risks different from, or possibly greater than, the risks associated with investing directly in securities and other traditional investments. These risks include risk of mispricing or improper valuation and the risk that changes in the value of the call option may not correlate perfectly with the underlying asset, rate or index. Put Options: An option contract giving the owner the right, but not the obligation, to sell a specified amount of an underlying security at a specified price within a specified time. This is the opposite of a call option, which gives the holder the right to buy shares. The risk of writing uncovered put options is substantial. The writer of an uncovered put option bears a risk of loss if the value of the underlying instrument declines below the exercise price. Such loss could be substantial if there is a significant decline in the value of the underlying instrument. Index: The Russell 1000 Index: a subset of the Russell 3000 Index, represents the 1000 top companies by market capitalization in the United States. The BXM: tracks the performance of a hypothetical covered call strategy on the S&P 500 Index. The S&P 500 Index: is an unmanaged composite of 500 large capitalization companies. This index is widely used by professional investors as a performance benchmark for large-cap stocks. Fundamental Analysis: A method of evaluating a security that entails attempting to measure its intrinsic value by examining related economic, financial and other qualitative and quantitative factors. Covered Call: An options strategy whereby an investor holds a long position in an asset and writes (sells) call options on that same asset in an attempt to generate increased income from the asset. This is often employed when an investor has a short-term neutral view on the asset and for this reason holds the asset long and simultaneously has a short position via the option to generate income from the option premium. Option Premium: The income received by an investor who sells or "writes" an option contract to another party.*
